

CPR Requirements & Training Options

CPR Requirement: valid adult & child required

1. CPR certification must be valid through the end of student teaching.
2. TC's must submit proof of certification by August 1st for fall start; January 1st for spring start.
3. Registration for internship will not be permitted until proof of CPR certification is submitted.
4. First Aid Certification is strongly recommended, but not required

CPR Training Options:

A. CPR In-Person Training:

- a. On campus through BLS Club: 3 dates each semester, specifically for Teacher Education students. Register here with this [link](#).

B. CPR Online:

- a. Please note, the site for the options below states that it meets and “adheres” to OSHA and AHA standards; it does not state that it is OSHA certified. So, it is possible that when you get a teaching job, the district may ask you to complete another training (most districts offer it for free to their employees).
