AGREEMENT FOR TRANSFER OF CREDIT
Between
Collbran Job Corps Center
Colorado Mesa University/Western Colorado Community College


This agreement provides for acceptance by the Technology Integration Program at Colorado Mesa University/Western Colorado Community College of credit earned through the Cisco Networking Technologies Program at Collbran Job Corps Center under the condition set forth and agreed to by the parties herein.

1. It is the responsibility of the instructors at the Cisco Networking Technologies Program at Collbran Job Corps Center to ensure that the student complete the necessary contact hours for each approved course or group of courses as listed in the chart included with this agreement and to provide written verification of competencies or content standards mastered.
2. The following documents must be provided to Colorado Mesa University/Western Colorado Community College in order that credit be awarded in the manner agreement upon in this agreement.
 - a. Certificate of Completion Issued by Collbran Job Corps Center
 - b. Letter of recommendation from Cisco Networking Technologies Program instructor at Collbran Job Corps Center
 - c. Training Achievement Record (E-TAR) signed by Collbran Job Corps Center (listed below).
3. The student must have been awarded a Colorado high school diploma or General Education Development certificate (GED) and be fully admitted into Colorado Mesa University/Western Colorado Community College and be enrolled at Colorado Mesa University/Western Colorado Community College as a degree-seeking student with a major in the Technology Integration Program in order to apply for the credit provided for in this agreement.
4. The student must have mastered the competencies for the Colorado Mesa University/Western Colorado Community College's Technology Integration Program by achieving for each course a score of 2.5 or higher on a scale of 1 through 3-competency measurement. Competency credit will be awarded according to the flow chart with a maximum of 23 credits awarded.

5. Colorado Mesa University/Western Colorado Community College will not charge tuition for these courses. There will be a one-time transcript-processing fee of \$5.00 per credit hour awarded. The credit agreed upon herein will not be noted on the student's Colorado Mesa University/Western Colorado Community College transcript until the student has successfully completed twelve credit hours of Colorado Mesa University/Western Colorado Community College coursework. The student must be in good standing at Colorado Mesa University/Western Colorado Community College to request acceptance of this credit.
6. The student must submit a completed Colorado Mesa University/Western Colorado Community College Escrowed Competency Credit Request form with all appropriate signatures and originals of the documents as listed in item #2 to the Colorado Mesa University/Western Colorado Community College Office of the Registrar in order to receive the agreed-upon competency credit.
7. Requests for acceptance of credit must be made not more than one (1) year past date of completion of the Cisco Networking Technologies Program at Collbran Job Corps Center or one (1) year past date of completion of GED or high school graduation.
8. This agreement is effective as of 1 Jan 2016 and will remain in effect for five (5) years or until terminated as in item #9 or until any substantive change is made with the relevant programs of either institution.
9. Each party may terminate this agreement by written notice delivered to the other party at least thirty (30) days prior to the commencement of classes for the net ensuing semester.
10. This agreement inures solely to the benefit of the parties and may not be enforced by others including others claiming to be third-party beneficiaries of this agreement.

11. If any clause or provision of this agreement be determined to be illegal, invalid or unenforceable under present or future laws, then it is the intention of the parties that the other terms and provisions of this agreement shall not be affected thereby.



AGREEMENT FOR CREDIT FOR CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT

Between

Collbran Job Corps Center


Colorado Mesa University/Western Colorado Community College

This agreement provides for acceptance by the Technology Integration Program at Colorado Mesa University/Western Colorado Community College of credit earned through the Cisco Networking Technologies Program at Collbran Job Corps Center under the condition set forth and agreed to by the parties herein.

1. It is the responsibility of the instructors at the Cisco Networking Technologies Program at Collbran Job Corps Center to ensure that the student complete the necessary contact hours for each approved course or group of courses as listed in the chart included with this agreement and to provide written verification of competencies or content standards mastered.
2. The following documents must be provided to Colorado Mesa University/Western Colorado Community College in order that credit be awarded in the manner agreement upon in this agreement.
 - a. Student filled out and turn in a completed Concurrent Enrollment Program Registration Form
 - b. Certificate of Completion issued by Collbran Job Corps Center
 - c. Certificate of Completion from the Cisco Networking Academy
 - d. Letter of recorded hours from Cisco Networking Technologies Program instructor at Collbran Job Corps Center
3. The student must have been awarded an Accredited High School diploma or General Education Development certificate (GED) and be fully admitted into Colorado Mesa University/Western Colorado Community.
4. The student must have mastered the competencies for the Colorado Mesa University/Western Colorado Community College's Technology Integration Program by achieving for each course a score of 2.5 or higher on a scale of 1 through 3-competency measurement. Competency credit will be awarded according to the flow chart with a maximum of 4 credits awarded.



7. Each party may terminate this agreement by written notice delivered to the other party at least thirty (30) days prior to the commencement of classes for the next ensuring semester.
8. This agreement inures solely to the benefit of the parties and may not be enforced by others claiming to be third-party beneficiaries of this agreement.
9. If any clause or provision of this agreement were determined to be illegal, invalid or unenforceable under present or future laws, then it is the intention of the parties that the other terms and provisions of this agreement shall not be affected thereby.
10. All students enrolled will create a Colorado Mesa University/Western Colorado Community College transcript at the end of the semester.




