- Study for the SAT and meet with your SAT test prep tutor once a week
- Register for the SAT
- Continue fostering positive relationships with teachers--they will be helpful in writing letters of recommendation!
- Register for concurrent enrollment courses in your desired career field

- Meet with your Upward Bound advisor at least once a week!
- Attend all Saturday activities

- Attend all Upward Bound meetings!
- Work with your UB Advisor to refresh and set new goals for your junior year
- If you haven't started already, get involved in some sort of volunteering or community service organization
- Start looking into TRiO-SSS programs at your prospective colleges
