

2024 senior timeline

January

- ☐ Request that your UB advisor or counselor submit an updated, mid-year transcript to your colleges.
- ☐ If you've taken concurrent enrollment classes, request official college transcripts be sent to all colleges you applied to!
- ☐ Create your FSAID and have your contributor create their FSAID before completing the 2024-2025 FAFSA form.
- ☐ **Complete the 2024-2025 FAFSA form.**
- ☐ Finish filling out the CMU Scholarship Application in your MAVzone. You need to complete the General Application before applying to any additional awards.
- ☐ Complete the housing application if you are wanting to live on-campus

February

- ☐ **Attend the FAFSA Night on February 5 at GJHS or February 6 at CHS**
- ☐ Complete the Western Colorado Community Foundation Scholarship Application that opens on February 1!
- ☐ Check your accepted student portals to ensure that colleges are not asking for additional documents (immunization records, social security cards, etc.)
- ☐ If you've taken Advanced Placement courses, register for upcoming exams

March

- ☐ Begin comparing financial aid awards and offers with your Upward Bound Advisor
- ☐ Complete the Reisher Ready application with your Upward Bound advisor by March 31

March (continued)

- ☐ Continue applying for additional scholarship opportunities like the Saccomanno Foundation Scholarship (due April 15).
- ☐ **Make your college decision!**

April

- ☐ Work with your UB Advisor to begin narrowing down your college options.
- ☐ Appeal any financial aid if you are eligible for with the help of your UB Advisor
- ☐ Take any placement tests for math, science, or English.
- ☐ Apply for and authorize the College Opportunity Fund (COF)
- ☐ **Complete your UB College Plan**

May

- ☐ Attend the Upward Bound End-of-Year Banquet and Celebration on Thursday, May 9 at 6:00 PM to receive your UB Honors cord!
- ☐ Apply for TRIO-SSS at CMU or at the institution you're attending!
- ☐ **Celebrate your graduation! You worked hard and deserve to enjoy this special day!**
- ☐ Write thank-you notes for any scholarships you have received or to any teachers that wrote recommendation letters
- ☐ Register for orientation--the earlier the better as this is where you will register for classes!
- ☐ Request your final high school transcript be sent to the college you are attending!
- ☐ If you took concurrent enrollment classes, submit your updated college transcripts.
