Grant Workshop for agricultural and urban water projects 6/25 at CMU

Grand Junction - The Water Center at Colorado Mesa University will host a grant workshop on funding opportunities for projects to address agricultural and municipal water needs in the Colorado and Gunnison basins. The workshop will be held on June 25 from 9am – noon in the CMU University Center, Room 221.

The workshop will focus on funding available through the Water Supply Reserve Account (WSRA) administered by the Colorado Water Conservation Board, with initial review by the Colorado and Gunnison Basin Roundtables. Past projects funded with WSRA funds include reservoir enlargements, irrigation headgate improvements, and studies.

At the workshop, representatives from the Colorado and Gunnison Basin Roundtables will discuss their screening criteria and preferences, and a representative from the Colorado Water Conservation Board will discuss statewide criteria for all WSRA grants, as well as criteria to qualify for statewide funds.

Parties with specific projects in mind are invited to prepare a short summary of their project to share at the workshop. Parties with a more general interest in the funding opportunity are also invited to attend.
