Dr. Morton Mower is a physician specializing in cardiology, and is Board-certified in internal medicine and cardiovascular diseases. He is a member of numerous professional organizations including the American Heart Association, American Congress of Cardiology, and the American Society for Artificial Internal Organs. He is the inventor of Cardiac Resynchronization Therapy for congestive heart failure and the Implantable Cardioverter-Defibrillator, and now continues research work in defibrillators and new uses for artificial pacemakers.

Dr. Mower currently serves on the Jewish National Fund Board of Directors and is the Vice President of the JNF Parsons Water Fund. The Fund supports Israeli initiatives that address issues of water quality, and trans-boundary challenges, with a focus on recycling, developing alternative water sources, education, stream and aquifer restoration, and research.
