Collin Robinson was raised in semi-arid Colorado, where the balance of life pivots on the fluctuating availability of water. He earned a Bachelor of Science in Civil Engineering and also a Master of Science in Civil and Environmental Engineering with a water resource specialty, both from Utah State University in Logan, where he worked at the Utah Water Research Laboratory. For a dozen years thereafter, he worked as a Water Resource Engineer in Colorado, first in the private sector, and then for the state, prior to starting his own practice, Guide Water, in 2017. Collin is licensed as a Professional Engineer, and has been since 2008. Collin works predominantly on projects to develop, manage, and protect water for beneficial agricultural, environmental, industrial, municipal, and domestic use. State water law, hydrology, and hydraulics form the foundation upon which such activities are based.
