Colorado's agriculture sector faces immense water resource challenges but is taking a leading role in developing innovative solutions. From Kremmling, Colorado, a story of a multi-generation ranching family working with the Colorado River Basin Roundtable and environmental organizations to explore innovative approaches to interstate water management; From the Rio Grande Basin, a story of local agricultural organizations working with the City of Denver to identify opportunities to conserve water and meet growing demands for local food; From the Eastern Plains, a story of concerned local leaders to develop a first of its kind peer education program to help farmers assess opportunities for sustaining the Ogallala Aquifer while maintaining agricultural viability.
