Mr. Cotner's involvement in water management is multi-faceted and spans several decades. Kevin is a third-generation farmer, where his first experience of applying this precious resource to the dry lands of Eastern Utah was done on his family's farm.

Kevin was the water master for the Carbon Canal from 1996 to 1999, while he served concurrently on the board of directors from 1996 to date. Kevin has held the office of president of Carbon Canal since 2010, where he manages twenty-three miles of open canal and oversees distribution to over three hundred shareholders servicing 11,000 acres.

From 2004 to 2008, Kevin served on the Utah Association of the Soil Conservation District, and traveled to Washington, DC to lobby for salinity funding for the Upper Colorado River Basin. The association was successful in securing over 5 million dollars for a winter stock water project and lateral improvements. He has been involved in several water projects such as, the Price River Diversion at the Carbon Country Club Golf Course, lining the canal above the Holiday Inn, and the Westwood Liner Project, both in Price.

Kevin has had the opportunity to appear before members of Congress representing Utah and Wyoming concerning drought contingency plans for the Upper Colorado River Basin and has addressed Utah State Legislature on more than one occasion, regarding water conservation and management. He has presented information and participated in conferences in Eastern Utah and Western Colorado.

Kevin is a small business owner, and he and his family farm over 600 acres. Their main crops include small grains, and non-GMO feed products.
