

Emergency Medical Technician

To apply for this program:

1. Submit a WCCC application for admission to the school as a student, you can do this online or at the WCCC Student Services office in Building B. This will assign you a 700# which is required before you can be registered into this program (not required for currently enrolled students).
2. Submit your EMT program application to WCCC Student Services office or to pholder@coloradomesa.edu, this will start the process.
3. Students will be notified of CONDITIONAL acceptance into the EMT or Paramedic Program and will be contacted by WCCC to confirm your intent to register.
4. **WCCC** will complete your registration for the required program courses.

Requirements:

Minimum of 18 years of age by the end of EMTS 102..
Hepatitis B vaccination (2 series) or Titer
Tetanus within the last 10 years
MMR vaccinations (2 series) (or Titer)
Two step TB Skin test (within 3 months of the class start date)
Current flu vaccination for the Fall and Spring Semesters
